### TALK IT OUT

Without judgement discuss what you hear, describing the quality of the sounds and the mood of the piece.

### **ACTIVELY RESPOND**

Engage further with what you hear by drawing a picture while listening, doing a dance or singing along.

### FORM AN OPINION

Talk about what you think about this style of music. Why do you like it? Or not?
